#### CUTE PENGUIN AMIGURIMI CROCHET PATTERN

This cute little guy is approximately 11-12 cm tall. A great gift for a child

Difficulty level: Intermediate

## WHAT YOU WILL NEED (A CHECKLIST):

Crochet hook: 2.00 mm	Sissors.
Materials: 1 pair of beads for eyes 6 mm	Yarn: 50% cotton / 50% acrylic
Fiberfill	l skein Green
Pins	1 skein white
Tapestry needle	1 skein yellow

#### Abbreviations used in this pattern:

Magic ring

- **ch** chain
- ss slip stitch
- sc single crochet
- inc increase: 2 sc in the same st

**dec** – decrease: 2 sc together. To decrease, insert your hook through the front loop of the indicated st, then insert your hook into the front loop of the next st. Your hook is now inserted into the front loops of both stitches you'd like to decrease into one stitch. Yarn over and draw up loop through both sts, then yarn over and pull through two loops on hook

(xx) - the number of stitches after ended round

### **STEP 3** The Flippers


 Rnd 1: Start with a magic ring. 6 sc in the magic ring
 Rnd 16: [7 sc, dec] x2 (14)

 Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st (12)
 Rnd 17: [6 sc, dec] x2 (12)

 Rnd 3: [1 sc, inc] x6 (18)
 Rnd 18: [5 sc, dec] x2 (10)

 Rnds 4-14: 1 sc in each st (18)
 Rnd 19: 1 ss in each st (10)

 Rnd 15: [8 sc, dec] x2 (16)
 Rnd 19: 1 ss in each st (10)





Cut off the yarn but be leave a long tail for sewing the wing onto the body – we'll need this later to attach the flippers to the body.

### **STEP 4 Beak**

Rnd 17

Rnd 1: Start with a magic ring. 6 sc in the magic ring Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st (12) Rnds 3-5: 1 sc in each st (12)

Cut off the yarn but be leave a long tail for sewing the beak onto the head
